Several Opportunities have emerged this week and a couple look quite compelling -

- 1. NGA's Police and Counterintelligence Office requires the procurement of a Subscription-based Web Analytics Services offering the broadest collection of public records used for locating and identifying individuals and businesses sounds quite compelling for any and all bidders.
- 2. TSA is issued a Request for Capability (RFC) and is looking for White Papers that primarily describe a company's capability to vet TSA Preè applicants by means other than biometrics (e.g., biographic data such as name, date of birth, etc.). This is a massive and extremely highprofile program for the TSA, as well as DHS S&T, and the future goals include exceeding 9 million applicants.

Finally, in the news, the momentum to merge OPM into GSA seems to be increasing – interesting to see that 80% of OPM revolving fund resources come from funds generating by doing background investigations. Who knew? The merger certainly begins to make a lot more sense knowing that information. Also, Acting Secretary of Homeland Security Kevin K. McAleenan visited the National Vetting Governance Board to thank representatives from multiple agencies for their work on standing up the new National Vetting Center (NVC). Clearly, this operation is an important one to keep your eyes at purvey ors of commercial intelligence on people, places, things and businesses.
