• A Request of Information (RFI) –Biometric Recognition and Identification at Altitude and Range (BRIAR) – The Office of the Director of National Intelligence's (ODNI)/ Intelligence Advanced Research Projects Activity (IARPA) "is seeking information on research efforts and datasets that may be useful in planning a program focused on advancing the state-of-the-art of biometric recognition and identification at altitude and range."

In other data news, NextGov's Aaron Bush covered GSA's recent release of 105 Q&A's received around the government's move away from D&B's D-U-N-S Number -- its entitled, "GSA Answers 105 Questions About Transition From DUNS To Unique IDs". Here's an excerpt:

• The DUNS Number system has been managed by Dun & Bradstreet since its inception and codified in the Federal Acquisition Regulation in 1998. Earlier this year, GSA awarded a five-year, \$42 million contract to Ernst & Young to manage the new unique identifier system, which is being dubbed the Unique Entity ID, a 12-character alphanumeric string. The new ID will replace the DUNS Number, a nine-character identifier that has been used since 1962.


