- Sources Sought - United States Special Operations Command (HQ USSOCOM) - Misinformation, Disinformation and Mal-Information Campaign Detection Prototype: The prototype will use a combination of deep learning, natural language processing, and dynamic network analysis to detect and examine the crossplatform spread of disinformation (in the form of images, video, and text) over vast and disparate data sources and inform teams of information which is intended to be deceptive. The vendor must address anomaly detection, deep fake, foreign influence and anticipatory analytics, leveraging deep learning, natural language processing, and proven machine learning development and capabilities.
