This week's issue is once again full of excellent and diverse opportunities for all readers of this newsletter; likewise, data and data analytics stories are quite abundant in not only the govcon trade press, but also some of the world's larger media outlets as well. We've highlighted a couple of the most compelling examples below:

• Request for Information (RFI) – issued by the **Department of the Air Force/United States Central Command (USCENTCOM)** – **Request for Information** - **Enterprise Capability for Vendor Vetting** – CENTCOM requires the following enterprise capabilities for Vendor Vetting...Multiple Domain Open Source search capability for vendor information such as Company Name, Key MGMT Personnel, email, physical address, name variance, bank account, family history, criminal records, related companies, passport info, etc. (See attachment 1 below for an example list of open source sites currently searched).

In other data news, on February 11th Homeland Security Today.com published a story entitled "GAO: TSA Needs Strategic Plan to Counter Insider Threats to Aviation" in which the author, Kylie Bielby, describes how aviation workers using their access privileges to exploit vulnerabilities and potentially cause harm at the nation's airports pose an insider threat. Highlights and related stories below:

• "From fiscal year 2017 through fiscal year 2019, there were an average of 138 insider threat referrals per month, with an average of 14 (again per month) requiring further investigation. Examples included a mechanic at Miami International who sought to sabotage an onboard aircraft component; a ground service agent who used his access to bard and fly an empty plane from Seattle-Tacoma Internationals; and a weapons smuggling operation at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International."
