• Request for Information (RFI) – issued by the **Defense Counterintelligence and Security Agency (DCSA)** – **Investigative Fieldwork Services** - This is an RFI used to identify potential business sources that are interested in, and capable of, providing investigative fieldwork services for Federal Background Investigations, as managed by DCSA's Personnel Vetting Field Operations Office, within an emerging DCSA environment. In addition, we seek vendor ideas or solutions that may aid in developing a future contract that can support emerging requirements such as continuous evaluation and continuous vetting, as defined by Executive Order 13467. In anticipation of significant changes to the background investigation and personnel vetting mission, DCSA seeks innovative solutions from vendors on how to accomplish this mission with increasing effectiveness through the use of new technologies and business processes that could be supported under a forthcoming procurement.

In other data news, on February 19th, **Washington Business Journal** published a story entitled "**Inside FiscalNote's turbulent 2019 and its CEO's plans for 2020**" in which the author, Andy Medici describes how FiscalNote Inc. CEO and co-founderTim Hwang was worried about facing a potential cash crunch in early 2019. Highlights and related stories below:

• "While Hwang said the company essentially raised what it set out to, albeit later than intended, sources and documents indicate how FiscalNote's rapid expansion and efforts to position itself for an IPO also led to some struggles last year. Several sources I spoke with for this story, who spoke on condition of anonymity because they were not authorized to speak for the company, stressed that FiscalNote's core concept was and continues to be a strong product idea. But the 18 months following the company's consummation of CQ Roll Call left its main products lying fallow, without substantial development or sufficient focus as Hwang pursued more acquisitions to grow FiscalNote's top-line revenue, according to these sources."
